

When dealing with Antiques, Collectibles, and General Household "Stuff", everyone wants to know two things: "What's It Worth?" and "What Can I Do with It?" That's exactly what our "What's It Worth" programs cover.

#### > Each Program Has 3 Parts:

- We start with a discussion on "Understanding Value".
- We perform **1-on-1 Appraisals** of all attendees' treasures.
- And offer *Buying, Selling & Value Tips* throughout the entire program.



#### Here Are A Few Additional 'What's It Worth' Thoughts:

- We offer morning, afternoon, and evening programs.
- It typically takes 2-3 minutes for each individual appraisal, so 25-30 people work best for a 2-hour program. However, there are options for accommodating larger groups.
- With smaller groups (15 or less), each attendee can have two items for Mike to appraise; larger groups work better with one item per person.
- While timing limits the number of appraisals we can perform during the 2-hour program, there is no limit on the number who can attend and watch the program.
- Participants should have one back-up item for Mike to appraise. That way, if he can't virtually see one item clearly, he can appraise the back-up item.
- Participants should have their items in-hand for Mike to appraise. A photo may work, actual items are usually better.
- Since Mike can't actually *Hold-Touch-Feel-See* the items in-person, he will most likely ask some questions to ascertain size, markings, condition, and other key characteristics.
